



The FMA has been in constant contact with the Department of Health to ensure that physicians and their staff have appropriate access to the vaccine, for their own use and to be able to assist in the effort to vaccinate others.

Florida's Surgeon General has assured us that the hospitals that receive both the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines will vaccinate health care workers from the community in addition to employees and staff of the receiving hospital. The FMA has requested and hopes to have more details from DOH soon.

For physicians that would like to serve the community by providing COVID-19 vaccinations, there are a number of steps that need to be taken.

1. You must enroll in Florida Shots. Go to [FLshotsUsers.com](https://www.flshots.com) or click here <https://www.flshots.com/flshots/enroll/Covid19EnrollInfo.html> to enroll. Be sure to check the "COVID-19 Enrollment" box.
2. Once you are enrolled in Florida Shots, complete Section A and B of the CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Program Provider Agreement [https://scdhec.gov/sites/default/files/media/document/COVID19-Vaccination Program Provider Agreement and Profile Form.pdf](https://scdhec.gov/sites/default/files/media/document/COVID19-Vaccination%20Program%20Provider%20Agreement%20and%20Profile%20Form.pdf). You must complete Section A prior to the completion of Section B for a given location. You will not be able to complete Section B until you have started the VFC/VFA enrollment process (see step 3 below).
3. After you have completed Section A of the CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Program Provider Agreement, Vaccines for Children (VFC) staff will contact you directly to begin the VFC enrollment process. Enrollment with the Florida VFC/VFA Program is required for each clinic location for which vaccines will be ordered and received. There is not an application or form to enroll in VFC/VFA.

If you can already directly access Florida Shots, log in as usual and proceed to "Enrollment" located under "COVID-19" in the main system menu. If you do not remember your login ID, call the Florida SHOTS help desk (877-888-7668, Option 2). If you need to reset your password, click "Need Password Assistance" on the Florida SHOTS login page.
