ICD-11

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1 Whereas, International Classification for Diseases version 11 (ICD-11) is becoming the
2 international standard of diagnosis, classification and coding for Medicine; and

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4 Whereas, The USA is still using the obsolete ICD-10 classification schema, which was not designed
5 for optimal digital/computer/artificial intelligence use; and

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7 Whereas, We recently changed over from ICD-9 CM to ICD-10 CM; and

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9 Whereas, The World Health Organization, of which we are no longer a member, is promulgating
10 ICD-11 for all Non-American Medical usage; therefore, be it

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12 **RESOLVED**, that the Florida Medical Association delegation to the AMA submit a resolution calling
13 for the AMA to advocate for the adoption of the International Classification of Diseases version 11
14 (ICD-11) as a replacement for ICD-10 for HIPAA-covered transactions by January 1, 2030.
