Newborn Mitochondrial Genome Screening
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- 1 Whereas, Human Genome DNA sequencing and analysis are now a medically and commercially
2 viable procedure; and
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4 Whereas, The early detection of known mutations that may cause disease may be important; and
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6 Whereas, The State of Florida routinely screens newborns for other conditions; therefore, be it
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8 RESOLVED, That the FMA will support legislation to provide for optional Newborn Mitochondrial
9 Genome DNA mutation analysis and that this screening require the written informed consent of the
10 parents or guardian.
